ASSESSMENT COURSE FEATURES

- TRAINING BUS Practice reading destination signs, boarding, playing fares, wheelchair navigation and securements.
- (2) UNEVEN SURFACE Evaluate gait and balance.
- 3 SIMULATED SURFACES (grass, rock, curb) To observe transition from surface to surface.
- (4) SLOPED SURFACE Test endurance and mobility.
- (5) TRAFFIC SIGNALS Teach pedestrian safety.
- (6) MOBILITY DEVICE **MEASUREMENT TOOLS**

Measures size and weight of person and device (wheelchair, scooter, etc.).

7 BIKE RACK Teach how to load bicycle.

TRIP SIMULATION

A Functional Assessment of Cognitive Transit Skills (F.A.C.T.S.) tool used nationally to assess a person's cognitive ability to use a Fixed Route bus system as well as teach way finding skills.
