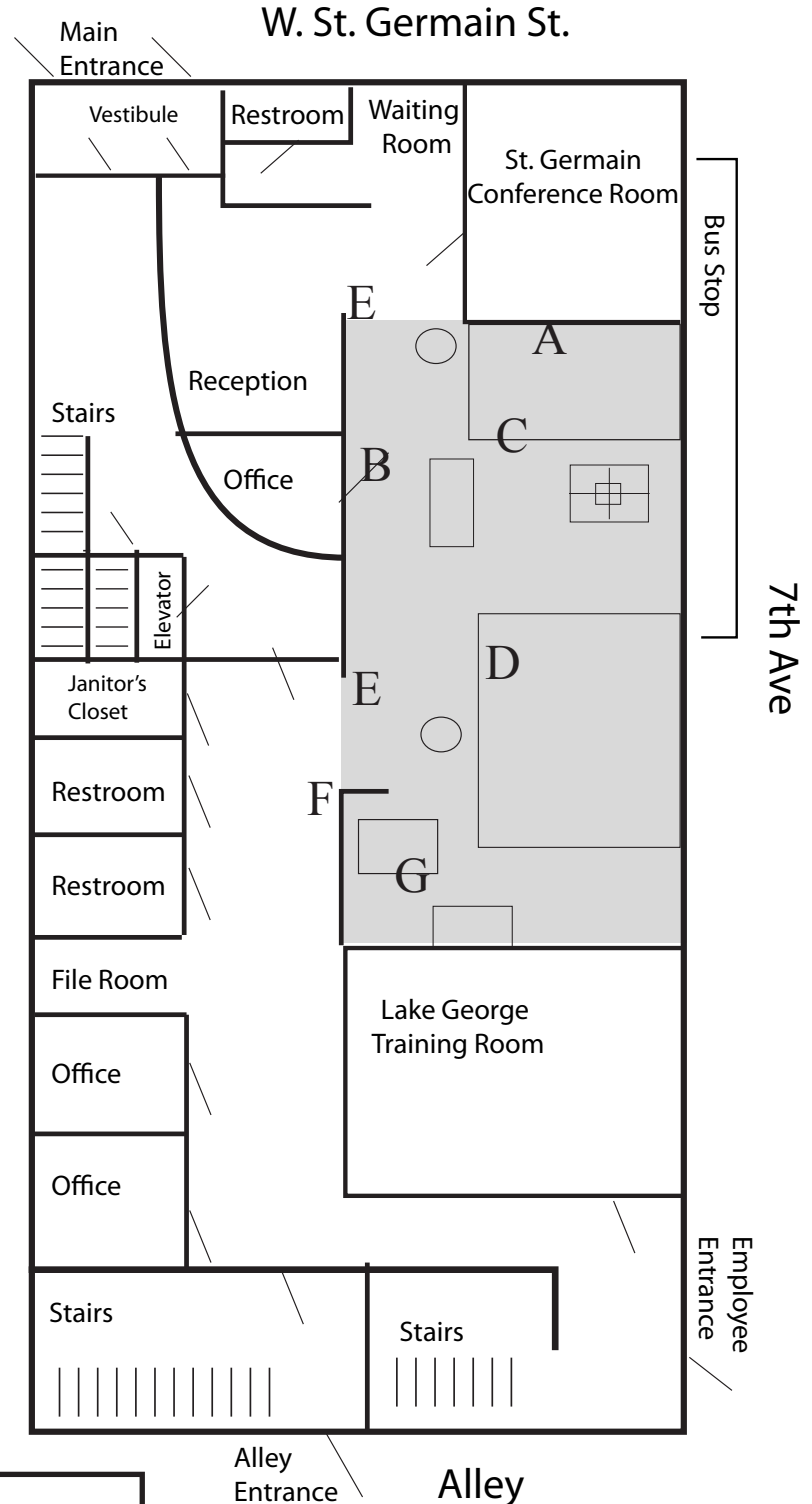
Assessment Course Features

Course is shaded

- A. Training Bus:** Practice reading destination signs, boarding, paying fares, wheelchair navigation and securements.
- B. Uneven Surface:** Evaluate gait & balance.
- C. Simulated Surfaces** (grass, rock, curb): Observe transition from surface to surface.
- D. Sloped Surface:** Test endurance & mobility.
- E. Traffic Signal:** Teach pedestrian safety.
- F. Mobility Device Measurement Tools:** Measures size and weight of person and device (wheelchair, scooter, etc.)
- G. Bike Rack:** Teach how to load bicycle.
- H. Trip Simulation** (not shown on diagram): The photos hung around the room are part of the Functional Assessment of Cognitive Transit Skills (F.A.C.T.S.) tool. This tool is used nationally to assess a person's cognitive ability to use a Fixed Route bus system as well as teach way finding skills.
